

Alopecia Areata Patient Priority Outcomes (AAPPO)

This questionnaire is scored as 6 independent AAPPO scores¹:

1. Hair loss on the scalp (question 1)
2. Hair loss on the eyebrows (question 2)
3. Hair loss on the eyelashes (question 3)
4. Hair loss on the body (question 4)
5. Emotional symptoms domain computed as the mean of questions 5-8, with the requirement that at least 2 domain items have nonmissing responses
6. Activity limitations domain computed as the mean of questions 9-11, with the requirement that at least 2 domain items have nonmissing responses

Each domain score ranges from **0** to **4**. The 4 hair loss items are scored individually using a 5-point response scale scored from 0 ("no hair loss") to 4 ("complete hair loss").¹ The extent of emotional symptoms are described using a 5-point scale ranging from "never" to "always," and activity limitations are described using a 5-point scale ranging from "not at all" to "completely." A total score from the 11 items is not recommended, as item-level correlations, factor analysis, and qualitative research conducted in the development of the AAPPO support scoring the 6 domains independently.
